Sub: Recognition of your university and fresh temporary approval of affiliation to Faculty of Law, Maharishi Arvind University, Jaipur, Rajasthan for imparting three year LLB, five year BBA LL.B law courses with an intake of one section of 60 students in each course.

Sir,

This is with reference to our letter mentioned above regarding recognition of your University . As desired by you I am once again sending the approval letter.

Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on **22nd October, 2016** considered the inspection report of **Faculty of Law, Maharishi Arvind University, Jaipur, Rajasthan.** After consideration, Committee made the following recommendations: -

The Committee considered the inspection report of Faculty of Law, Maharishi Arvind University, Jaipur, Rajasthan and further, Committee is of the view that as per Section 7 (1) (i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 University be granted recognition for the purpose of conferring the degree of law for imparting three year LLB and five year BBA.LLB law courses and also granted fresh approval of affiliation for running LL.B three year course and BBA LL.B integrated five year course with an intake of one section of 60 students in each section in each course for a period of two years i.e. for the academic year 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 subject to the following conditions.

Though, the approval has been granted to start the courses, but to cover up the shortage for the shorter period of the course to be undertaken it is important that each centre of legal education must take extra classes to cover the total course as per the syllabus under the Bar Council of India rules. Under the syllabus, each subject must have 30 hours per week. The college can calculate the same and accordingly extend their extra classes to update the students as per syllabus.
